Edgewood College Application Checklist

Submit all documents to Sara Friar (sfriar@edgewood.edu) in the Center for Global Education.

- Complete the online Edgewood College International Application: <http://www.edgewood.edu/apply>
 - Apply as a non-degree seeking student.
 - Undergraduate Students: International Undergraduate Application; Use fee waiver code: 109.
 - Graduate Students: International Graduate Application; Use fee waiver code 191

 - An official transcript from Masaryk University demonstrating 2 years of successful college-level study (undergraduates) or completion of a bachelor's degree (graduate students). The equivalent of a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) or higher is required.

 - A personal statement of 300 to 500 words written by the student in English addressing the following: *Introduce yourself and explain your goals for studying at Edgewood College as well as your goals for integrating into the culture of the United States. What specific situations from your past have helped you prepare to accomplish these goals?*

 - Proof of English proficiency. Applicants must prove English proficiency by submitting one of the following documents:
 - TOEFL score of 71 or higher on the internet-based test (IBT) or 525 or higher on the paper-based test (PBT) (For more information visit www.toefl.org)
 - IELTS score of 6.0 or higher (www.ielts.org)
 - A transcript demonstrating successful completion of 1 year of college-level work completed entirely in English.
 - Review and approval by Edgewood College staff or faculty of a completed Edgewood College Language Proficiency Report. (Request form from Sara Friar)

 - Proof of financial support for the duration of study at Edgewood College. Provide proof of financial support in the amount of \$3,500 USD. As part of the exchange, Masaryk students will not be charged for tuition, residence hall, and meal plan at Edgewood College. You are responsible to pay for the Edgewood College international student health insurance, books, and any other personal expenses. The most common way to demonstrate financial support is in the form of an official bank statement or proof of a scholarship.
Financial documents must:
 - Be original letters or statements from a financial institution with original ink signatures and stamps (copies of original documents will also be accepted)
 - Be written in English or accompanied by official English translation and indicate unit of currency
 - If a sponsor is providing financial support, the document must include both the sponsor's name and student's name exactly as it appears on student's application
 - Be dated within six months of application date
- Students should request additional original documents to present to the U.S. Consulate or Embassy when requesting a student visa, and to present to immigration officials when entering the United States.
- Color photocopy of the ID page of your passport.
