<p>Clinical electives/ research stays</p>	<p>The acceptance for research stays is subject to the approval of the corresponding <i>Centro Universitario (Campus)</i>.</p> <p>The acceptance for clinical electives stays is subject to the approval of the corresponding <i>O.P.D. Hospital Civil de Guadalajara</i>.</p> <p>Practically all the areas are available for a rotation; however, the Hospital Civil must check and evaluate each stay before it starts, given that a situation could arise that prevents acceptance.
