What is the ESC - European Student Card?

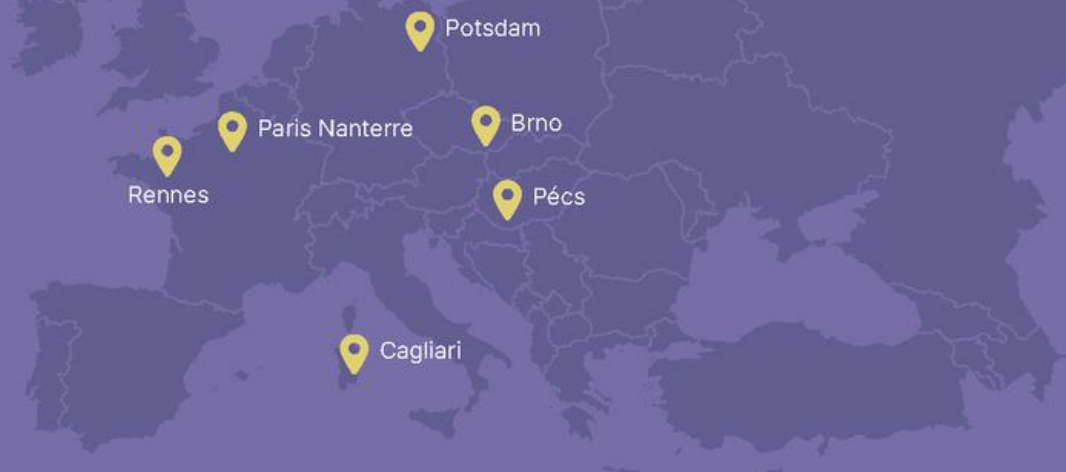
The ESC is not a new card, it's just your regular student card, but **upgraded with a European scope!**

Principle: anywhere in Europe, your student status will be recognized

- A common graphic identity thanks to a European hologram on the student card, which allows a quick visual check
- A European Student Identifier (ESI) which identifies the student through all the applications and services developed, thanks to a European digital platform
- A QR code that certifies your "student status" and its validity via a smartphone or a simple QR code reader.

The purpose of the student card has always been to allow identification of student status. In recent years, most student cards have evolved becoming multi-service cards. Now, through the ESC not only student status and identity are recognized everywhere in Europe, but it can also allow you to get easy access to services without the need to register for a new card during your mobility.

After an experimental phase and as a 1st step, the card will allow you to register at any library and enjoy the services provided (book borrowing, online resources, WIFI, printing, etc.) in all the campuses of the EDUC Alliance.

Masaryk University

As a student of Masaryk University, you may be issued an ESC card to enjoy the possibilities of ESC at other European universities.

How to receive and use your European Student Card?

1. Request a new student card through MU Shopping Centre or through the Faculty Study Department.
2. You will be given the European Student Identifier (ESI) and your card will have European Student Card Number (ESCN).
3. Give your consent with sharing your data to ESC platform through MU Information System (*Privacy > Manage Privacy > ESC consent*).
4. Pick up your new ESC card at your Faculty Study Department within 3-4 days.
